## Freedom of Information Request - FOI2024/01582

We are writing in response to your email received by Post Office Limited ("**Post Office**") on 09 December 2024, which has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("**FOIA**").

In your email, you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

"I am hoping you can direct me to the correct person to speak too unless of course you can supply the information yourselves

I am looking for a list of the post offices that did not sign up to the new Allwyn license in respect of the National Lottery as I would like to contact them all directly"

We can confirm that Post Office does not hold the information you have requested.

Post Office decided not to renew its agreement with the lottery operator when Camelot lost the licence to Allwyn. This took effect when Allwyn took over operation of the National Lottery in February 2024.

Postmasters were then able to apply directly to Allwyn. Allwyn also reached out to the postmasters and retailers directly, and so Post Office was not involved in the individual applications. For reasons of commercial confidentiality and data protection, Allwyn were unable to share details of applicants or success or otherwise with Post
